### EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 0026, S-2022

#### PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF THE ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND CONSERVATION OFFICE (EECO) UNDER THE MUNICIPAL PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICE (MPDO) OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF ASINGAN, PANGASINAN, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 11285, otherwise known as the “Energy Efficiency and Conservation Act,” has for its primary goal the establishment of a framework for introducing and institutionalizing fundamental policies on energy efficiency and conservation, including the promotion of efficiency and judicious utilization of energy, increase in the utilization of energy efficiency and renewable energy technologies and the delineation of responsibilities among various government agencies and private entities”;

**WHEREAS**, under the Implementing Rules and Regulation (IRR) of Republic Act No. 11285 issued on November 22, 2019, the local government units (LGUs), except barangays, shall establish their respective Energy Efficiency and Conservation Office (EECO), which may be a part of the planning and development office, using appropriations from their general funds established under the Local Government Code;

**WHEREAS**, the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Officer (Enercon Officer) shall head the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Office; and within three years from the effectivity of the IRR, the Head of the Municipal Planning and Development Office shall be considered as the Enercon Officer of the Municipal Government of Asingan, Pangasinan;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Engr. CARLOS F. LOPEZ, JR.**, Municipal Mayor of Asingan, Pangasinan, premises considered, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, by expressed authority provided for by law to the Local Chief Executive, hereby order the following:

**SECTION 1. CREATION AND COMPOSITION.** The Energy Efficiency and Conservation Office (EECO) is hereby created, and it shall be integrated into the Municipal Planning and Development Office (MPDO).

The Head of the MPDO, **Engr. EMETERIO E. LAROYA**, shall likewise head the EECO and may invite select officers and staff members of the Municipal Government of Asingan to form a consultative body in order to enforce and implement the provisions of the IRR of RA No. 11285.

**SECTION 2. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS.** The EECO headed by the Enercon Officer shall perform the following functions:

- Develop and implement, with the assistance of the Department of Energy (DOE) and in coordination with the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), the Municipal Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan, and incorporate the same to the Municipal Development Plan;
- Recommend, through the Municipal Development Council, and endorse, if necessary, to the Sangguniang Bayan, energy efficiency projects in the Municipal Investment Priority Area and grant applicable incentives, including assistance or fast-tracking of permits or licenses indicated in Local Investment Incentives Plan (LIIP) to establishments with energy efficient projects upon registration and compliance with the requirements of the Municipal Government;





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- c. Prepare energy performance report that contain, among others, the monthly breakdown of its energy performance and such other information to be prescribed by the Department of Energy (DOE) and submit such report to the IAEECC, copy furnished the DOE, not later than the prescribed periods;
- d. Enter into different financial arrangements for energy efficiency projects, whenever desirable and warranted, following the procedures laid down in any of the following measures, namely:
  - 1) RA No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act;
  - 2) RA No. 6957, otherwise known as the BOT Act, as amended by Republic Act No. 7718;
  - 3) RA No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;
  - 4) The 2013 NEDA Joint Venture Guidelines, as may be amended from time to time;
  - 5) RA No. 7926, otherwise known as the Charter of the City of Muntinlupa;
  - 6) Related laws, rules and regulations and other modalities
- e. Ensure the implementation of mandated responsibilities provided in the statutes and laws enumerated above, and coordinate with the DOE Regional and Field Offices related to the implementation of the same;
- f. Perform such other functions as may be directed by competent authority, or as may be necessary to accomplish the foregoing.


**SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All orders, rules, regulations, and other related issuances inconsistent with or contrary to this Order are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly. All other provisions of existing issuances which are not affected by this Order shall remain valid and in effect.

**SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** In the event any provision in this Order shall be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be affected or impaired thereby.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY.** This Order shall take effect immediately.
