EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 018, SERIES OF 2025

PROMULGATING THE IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR THE USE OF THE MOBILE COMPUTER LEARNING TRUCK OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF ASINGAN, PANGASINAN AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, every local government unit shall exercise the powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental to its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, Section 447(a)(5)(x) of Article III of the same Code empowers the Sangguniang Bayan to adopt measures to promote the welfare of the inhabitants and, in particular, to establish and provide for the operation of vocational and technical schools and similar post-secondary institutions;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Asingan, Pangasinan, in its thrusts to promote inclusive, accessible, and quality digital education, acquired a Mobile Computer Learning Truck equipped with information and communication technology tools to serve various learners across the municipality;

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish uniform guidelines and procedures to ensure the efficient utilization, management, scheduling, and maintenance of the Mobile Computer Learning Truck;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ENGR. CARLOS F. LOPEZ, JR. Municipal Mayor of Asingan, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following

SECTION 1. OBJECTIVE. This Order aims to establish clear and uniform implementing guidelines for the use and management of the Mobile Computer Learning Truck to ensure its effective, equitable, and sustainable operation; institute a standardized and accountable procedure for the deployment and use of the MCLT; and ensure the sustainability, security, and effectiveness of the MCLT as an educational tool.

SECTION 2. COVERAGE. This Order shall cover the use and regulation of the MCLT in all barangays within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Asingan.

SECTION 3. ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROL AND SUPERVISION. The MCLT shall be under the administrative supervision of the Office of the Municipal Mayor, in coordination with the Public Information Office or its equivalent departments or committees.

SECTION 4. MANAGEMENT AND OPERATION. The following LGU personnel are hereby designated as Computer Literacy Facilitators, who shall render instruction, technical assistance, and support services related to the implementation of digital education programs through the MCLT:

MARK ALLAIN MERIALES – Administrative Aide III GILBERT ECLERA, JR. – Administrative Aide III NORBERT VELASQUEZ – Job Order MARK DAVE SANTILLA – Job Order

SECTION 5. FUNCTIONS OF MCLT MANAGEMENT TEAM. The MCLT, in coordination with concerned national government agencies, instrumentalities and stakeholders, shall perform the following functions:

- (1) Oversee the technical operation, maintenance, deployment, operations, documentation, and reporting of all MCLT activities and;
 - (2) Assist in teaching basic computer operations and literacy;

SECTION 7. UTILIZATION GUIDELINES. The Management shall strictly comply with the following guidelines and rules in relation to the proper use and operation of the MCLT:

- a. Only officially sanctioned activities related to digital literacy, ICT education, and community-based e-learning shall be allowed;
- b. The MCLT may not be used for partisan political activities, private gain, or commercial purposes;
 - c. Users must maintain the cleanliness and integrity of all equipment; and
- d. Any damage due to negligence or misuse shall be subject to accountability under applicable civil service and administrative laws.

SECTION 8. MONITORING AND EVALUATION. A quarterly review and evaluation of the MCLT operations shall be conducted by the implementing office. Recommendations for policy adjustments, if any, shall be submitted to the Sangguniang Bayan for appropriate legislative action. A regular preventive maintenance program shall be instituted for the vehicle and its ICT components and there shall be a utilization and activity report to be submitted monthly to the Office of the Municipal Mayor.

SECTION 9. FUNDING. Operational expenses for the maintenance, fuel, instructional materials, and allowance of designated facilitators shall be charged to the appropriate LGU funds, subject to availability and accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. All orders, rules, regulations, and other related issuances inconsistent with or contrary to this Order are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly. All other provisions of existing issuances which are not affected by this Order shall remain valid and in effect.

SECTION 11. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. In the event any provision in this Order shall be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be affected or impaired thereby.

SECTION 12. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately.
