EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 035, S-2024

CONSTITUTING THE MUNICIPAL SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, AND INNOVATION COUNCIL (MSTIC) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF ASINGAN, PANGASINAN, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSE

WHEREAS, Section 10 Article XIV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that Science and Technology are essential for national development and progress. That the state shall give priority to research and development, invention, innovation and their utilization; and to science and technology education, training and services. It shall support indigenous, appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities and their application to the country's productive systems and national life;

WHEREAS, the National Government's 8-point socioeconomic agenda include, "#1 Protect purchasing power and mitigate socioeconomic scarring, ensure food security, #4 Create more jobs, promote trade and investments, #Create quality jobs, encourage R&D innovation and enhance the digital economy, #6 Create green jobs, purse a green and blue economy and establish livable and sustainable communities";

WHEREAS, the present direction towards globalization dictates that only those who are in formal education access contemporary advances in technology; equally important is the vital role of science and technology in almost all facets of our day-to-day activities and survival;

WHEREAS, Science, Technology, and Innovation are directed towards affordable and cost-effective food production, sustainable livelihoods using indigenous raw materials and various inventions for efficient and systematic agricultural manufacturing;

WHEREAS, the DOST is the primary agency mandated to lead in Science and Technology Development and ensure access of LGUs to their innovations, programs, and projects through capability building as strategy for poverty reduction, gender and development—women empowerment initiative, and other community-based social services promotion;

WHEREAS, to fully implement the Projects, Programs, and Activities of Local Government Unit related to Science and Technology, the creation of a Municipal Science, Technology and Innovation Council (MSTIC) is imperative;

WHEREAS, Researches and Development (R&D) focus it research outputs on addressing the country's issues on equality, employment, and economic competitiveness;

WHEREAS, the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) is the primary agency mandated to provide central direction, leadership and coordination of scientific and technological efforts and ensure that the results therefrom are geared and utilized in areas of maximum economic and social benefits for the people;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Engr. CARLOS F. LOPEZ, JR, Municipal Mayor of Asingan, Pangasinan by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree the following:

SECTION 1. CREATION AND MANDATE. The Municipal Science, Technology, and Innovation Council (MSTIC) is hereby created under the Office of the Municipal Mayor. the Council shall be coordinated by Arch. EXCEL JETHER C. BAUTISTA, Local Treasury Operation Officer, as the Focal Person.

SECTION 2. COMPOSITION. The Municipal Science, Technology, and Innovation Council (MSTIC) shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The MSTIC shall have the following duties:

a) Formulate and adopt a Comprehensive Municipal Science and Technology Plan;

b) Promote public awareness and appreciation of Science and Technology;

c) Encourage and facilitate active participation of the community in scientific and technological activities;

d) Establish partnership with other sectors in promoting the development of indigenous technology utilizing the domestic materials available in the locality and in strengthening scientific and technological capability by the various sectors in the municipality;

e) Undertake activities to promote technological services needed in agriculture, industry,

academe, and the general public.

SECTION 4. SECRETARIAT. The Secretariat shall be headed by Focal Person, and shall perform the following functions:

 a) Prepare the minutes, agenda, and records the attendance and proceedings of all meetings of the council;

b) Serves notice of meetings to all members of the council;

c) Furnishes the officers and members certified copies of the minutes of the meetings;

d) Keeps a register of the names and address of all members and keeps a complete file of the laws, resolutions and executive orders relevant to the creation of the council; and

e) In general, perform all duties incidental to the Office of the Secretariat.

SECTION 5. MEETING. The council shall meet quarterly; provided however that the Chairperson may convene the committee anytime whenever necessary.

SECTION 6. FUNDING. The fund needed to implement the various Programs, Projects, and Activities on Science and Technology shall be incorporated in the Annual Appropriations of the Local Government Unit.

SECTION 7. SUPPLEMENTARY CLAUSE – On matters not provided in this Order, any applicable laws and their corresponding implementing rules and regulations, executive orders and relevant issuances therefore shall be applied in a supplemental manner.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE. All orders, rules, regulations, and other related issuances inconsistent with or contrary to this Order are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly. All other provisions of existing issuances which are not affected by this Order shall remain valid and in effect.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. In the event any provision in this Order shall be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be affected or impaired thereby.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately.
