EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 051, S. 2022

REORGANIZING THE LOCAL PUBLIC TRANSPORT ROUTE PLANNING (LPTRP) TEAM OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ASINGAN, PANGASINAN, DESIGNATING ITS TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP AND SECRETARIAT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSE

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State to ensure the implementation of an efficient and reliable public transport system as a vital component of economic development, and as a program that will serve the public's transportation needs;

WHEREAS, the DOTr-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 001, s. 2017 was issued to mandate local governments for the preparation, submission, and adoption of Local Public Transport Route Plan (LPTRP)—a basic requirement prescribed for the issuance of Public Utility Vehicle (PUV) franchises, which shall be guided by the Local Transport Route Plan Manual that details route networks, modes, and required number of units per mode, to deliver public land transport services;

WHEREAS, several issuances such as DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2018-60 reiterates the guidelines for the LGUs on the preparation of the LPTRP; MC No. 2018-39 apprising LGUs' training schedules and capacity-building activities; and other directives advising of regional, provincial, and local efforts to intensify the preparation and submission of the LPTRP;

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum dated March 13, 2019, as reiterated through the MC 2021-139, was issued relative to the Regional Compliance Report on the Local Transport Route Plan (LPTRP) preparation and submission by the local government, per the Public Utility Vehicle (PUV) Modernization Program;

WHEREAS, there is a need to reorganize and strengthen the Local Public Transport Route Plan (LPTRP) Team of Asingan, Pangasinan to oversee the crafting of the LPTRP and ensure that all plans, programs, projects, orders, ordinances, and other issuances are implemented in accordance with the JMC No. 001-2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Engr. CARLOS F. LOPEZ, JR., Local Chief Executive of the Municipality of Asingan, Pangasinan, premises considered, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree:

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION. The reorganized LPTRP Team shall be composed of:

SECTION 2. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. The LPTRP Team shall have the following duties:

- Assess and evaluate the existing public transport and traffic conditions in the municipality;
- Collect public transport and traffic data to support the assessment and evaluation of existing public transport and traffic conditions in the municipality;
- Collect, analyze, and forecast data on public transport demand in the municipality taking into consideration current passenger demand, local land use and development plans covering various sectors such as agriculture, tourism, industries, and others;
- Formulate alternative public transport and traffic improvement measures and evaluate the alternatives in order to identify the most viable measures;
- Coordinate with various stakeholders in public transport and traffic systems such as service providers, citizen's groups, government institutions, and non-government organizations in the planning, monitoring, and evaluation of LPTRP;
- Prepare a local transport plan and supporting traffic management plan consisting of public transport route alignments and corresponding measured capacities, public transport facilities, traffic management improvement measures to address current and future conditions;
- Submit the LPTRP to LTFRB through the local chief executive for review and evaluation;
- Recommend the LPTRP to the local council for council resolution;
- Design an LPTRP monitoring and evaluation system;
- Implement actual monitoring and evaluation of LPTRP operations; and
- Update and revise the LPTRP as needs arise in the future in accordance with standard public transport planning procedure.

SECTION 3. TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP. A TWG of the LPTRP Team is hereby created to craft the Local Public Transport Route Plan to be constituted by the following:

SECTION 4. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE SECRETARIAT. In order to assist it in the discharge of its functions, the secretariat of the LPTRP Team shall be responsible in the documentation of the proceedings, preparation of reports and other secretarial works required.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All orders, rules, regulations, and other related issuances inconsistent with or contrary to this Order are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly. All other provisions of existing issuances which are not affected by this Order shall remain valid and in effect.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. In the event any provision in this Order shall be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be affected or impaired thereby.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately.
